

The Manitoba Amateur Wrestling Association (MAWA) is seeking Provincial Coaches and a team Manager to lead Manitoba's team at the upcoming National Cadet/Juvenile and Junior Tournaments in March and April of 2012. MAWA is looking to assemble a team consisting of a head and two assistant coaches as well as a team manager. The successful team members will have a proven track record of working well with other coaches, motivating and developing high performance athletes within a respectful environment. Communication with parents and the ability to create a respectful environment are essential qualifications. The successful coaching candidate for the position of head coach will be a minimum of NCCP certified level 3. Assistant coaches must be trained NCCP Competition Introduction and be prepared to become certified Competition Introduction by March 15, 2012. All staff must have completed the respect in sport course offered by Sport Manitoba and submit to a child abuse and criminal registry check. The coaches and managers will be expected to engage and further develop the prospective and selected male and female athletes comprising the MB provincial team. The coaches will be eligible for an honorarium TBA. MAWA will be responsible for all travel costs to National events and other events in preparation. The primary responsibility will be for the period Feb. 1 to April 30th, 2012.

The MAWA board is also accepting applications for coaches who would like to be part of a pool of coaching staff for the 2013 Canada Summer Games which will be held in Sherbrook Quebec August 2013. Members of this coaching pool will share responsibilities for the training of potential Canada Games athletes. The actual coaching staff for the games will be selected from this coaching pool at a later date.

Please indicate whether you are applying for a Provincial Team Coaching Staff position, Canada Games Coaching staff pool or both. It is hoped that the successful applicants for the Provincial Team coaching staff will also apply to be part of the coaching pool for Canada games. COACH SELECTION POLICY

Manitoba Amateur Wrestling Association (MAWA)

Each application shall include a coaching resume and a copy of the applicant's NCCP transcript. Head Coach shall be **certified** to at least Level 3 in Wrestling or the equivalent under the new NCCP for the sport of wrestling Competition Development context (Trained status). Assistant coaches must be **certified** Competition Introduction by March 15, 2012.

ARTICLE I

MANAGERS

ARTICLE I

Selection of Managers:

6. The selection and appointment of managers is done by the MAWA Executive Committee and/or its designate.
7. The chosen candidates and back up will also be made public.
