Tournament Schedule

Friday

5:30-7pm: Weigh-ins.

7:15 MAWA AGM (upper level of the U of W Duckworth Center)

Saturday

8:30-9:30am: Elementary "Red Dot" weigh-ins @ competition venue.

10am-1pm: Elementary & Jr. Tournament.

1pm-5:30pm: High School Tournament.

Competition will take place on 3 mat surfaces.

Athlete Registration:

Coaches are asked to pre-register their Jr. & H.S. athletes by submitting their names via e-mail to mawawrestling@mymts.net by 1 pm on Wednesday March 9th as to allow tournament officials to prepare weigh-in slips in advance.

Weigh Ins:

Jr. & High School age groups will be weighed in on Friday March 11th, 5:30pm to 7:00pm at the competition venue. Elementary competitors weights are to be sent to mawawrestling@mymts.net no later than 12 noon on Thursday March 10th, 2 athletes from each program will selected for "Red Dot" weigh-ins & will be weighed in Saturday morning from 8:30-9:30am. Athletes more than 1 kg. overweight will result in the entire team being re-weighed and/or possibly suspended.

Elementary & Jr. High: These age groups will be grouped into pools of 4-5 athletes competing in a "Round Robin" format.

High School: Athletes will be entered into the following weight classes as set forth by the CAWA, alternatively where are insufficient numbers of contestants the "pooling" system will be implemented at the draw master's discretion and approved by the Head Official.

Female – Cadet/Juvenile **38, 40, 43, 46, 49, 52, 56, 60, 65, 70, 75, 82 KG**

Men – Cadet/Juvenile **42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 63, 66, 69, 72, 76, 80, 85, 92, 100, 115, 130 KG**

Officials will be conducting a skin check at weigh-ins with NO weight allowance for Jr. & HS. age groups.

Eligibility:

Elementary – born 1999 and later.

Junior High – grades 7 – 9 (born 1996-1998)

High School – grades 9 – 12 (but must have been under 18 on Dec. 31, 2010). If you have an athlete who does not meet these criteria but you feel should be eligible to compete in the high school division please contact Geoff Thompson, Head Official by email: grthompson@shaw.ca to see if an exception may be granted.

Entry Fees: \$20.00 per entry.

Awards: Awards will be presented for the top 3 finishers in each age group. There will be "Outstanding Wrestler" awards for both male & female competitors in the Jr. & High School age categories.

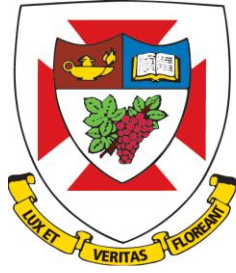
