U.S. participants must hold valid U.S. Wrestling Card. Canadian participants must be current members of their Provincial **Wrestling** PSO (e.g. MAWA, SAWA, OAWA etc.)

These membership requirements will be clearly posted on all promotional materials for the event.

This information is necessary for insurance purposes. Out of province participants must provide proof of insurance (membership card for any provincial association is acceptable proof. U. S. participants must present valid U.S. Wrestling Card).

The event must use only Officials who are certified members of the Manitoba Amateur Wrestling Officials Association as supplied by MAWA. **MAWA reserves the right to demand a deposit to cover the cost of hiring officials as a condition for sanctioning approval.**

The event should feature a skin check for infectious skin conditions, including ringworm and qualified first aid personnel must be on site at all times during tournaments.

CERTIFICATION:

It is hereby agreed that the organizers of this event will adhere and conform to competition and activity standards established by MAWA with respect to the competition site, officiating, safety features, and any other aspect involved in organizing, producing and advertising this event. It is further agreed that this competition/activity will be conducted in the manner prescribed by the current rules and regulations as defined by MAWA and Wrestling Canada.

Note: A MAWA sanctioned event adheres to the following criteria:

1. An advertised event
2. Certified MAWA/CAWO officials are used.
3. MAWA/Wrestling Canada rules are used
4. Qualified emergency medical personnel must be on hand and approved safety equipment must be used.
5. All participants in any capacity without exception must be members in good standing of the Manitoba Amateur Wrestling Association or of their respective provincial or state governing body.

Events that must be sanctioned are:

To get your Activity sanctioned:

Step 1 - Complete Sanction Request Application Form

Any MAWA member club wishing to host a MAWA sanctioned event, must complete and submit a *Sanction Request Application Form* to MAWA. The application must be completed in full and returned 60 days prior to the event. Applicants will receive a confirmation of approval of sanction for their event by email.

Step 2 – Event Coordinator’s Report.

Upon completion of the event, event coordinator must submit an Event Follow up report, consisting of a list of all participants and results to MAWA as well as any incident reports. This must be completed within 1 week of event.

Step 3 – Compliance to the rules and regulations

Clubs applying to host any sanctioned competitive event must be aware and be able to comply with the technical rules and regulations set by MAWA and the Wrestling Canada.

Failure to sanction an event:

Failure to apply to MAWA for any level of planned events under the sanctioning policies and procedures will jeopardize members' insurance coverage provided by MAWA for all participants. Any scores arising from such competitions may not be used or counted as fair and legal results. Failure to comply with any of the host's responsibilities before, during, or after the event could also result in disciplinary action by MAWA.

Certain exceptions to these policies may be made for clubs hosting tournaments 100km beyond the city of Winnipeg perimeter. All exceptions will be at the discretion of the MAWA Board.
